A temporary GPA dip common during the first semester after transfer.

Causes of "Transfer Shock"

- New Environment/Adjustment Difficulties
- Academic Rigor/Advanced Courses
- Unaware of resources
- Imposter Syndrome



Your support makes a big difference – remind them they have the tools and resilience to succeed!

Imposter Syndrome

- Combat It!
- Talk about it
- Validate the feelings
- Connect with the Transfer Center
- It's normal to feel self-doubt, but your student belongs here!

Help your student start strong!

- ✓ Submit all final documents
- ✓ Review degree audit & Pegasus Path plan
- ✓ Check Transfer Credits
- ✓ Clear any holds or to-do items
- ✓ Check the academic calendar for key dates
- ✓ Check email for important updates





They should have regular check-ins with their Academic Success Coach – encourage them to NOT wait until registration!

- ☐ Speak up early about any concerns
- ☐ Ask for study strategies
- ☐ Understand grades & assignments
